Hey Duggee With Autumn Accessories Crochet Pattern

Head / body:

Yarn A – Dark Brown

1. dc6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (dc3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (dc4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (dc5, inc) x6 (42)
- 8-9. dc around (42) - 2 rounds
10. (dc6, inc) x6 (48)
- 11-17. dc around (48) - 7 rounds
18. Change to yarn C and dc around (48)

Materials needed:

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle
- Toy stuffing
- 5mm safety eyes (x2)

Yarn:

Any DK Cotton in

- A - Dark brown (head/body) x2 balls
- B - Light brown (mouth) x1 ball
- C - Lemon yellow (tie) x1 ball
- D - Warm yellow (shirt) x1 ball
- E - Sand (trousers) x1 ball
- F - Navy (top of scarf) x1 ball
- G - Black (nose) x1 ball
- H - A long strand of dark red yarn (for mouth detail)

Terminology (UK Terms):

- slst: slip stitch
- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- MR: Magic ring
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease

19. dc around (48)
20. Change to yarn D and dc around (48)
- 21-29. dc around (48) - 9 rounds
30. Change to yarn E and dc around (48)
- 31-33. dc around (48) - 3 rounds *insert safety eyes between rows 10-11 with 1st apart* (fig.1)
34. dec x24 (24) *start stuffing the body here and keep going with each row*
35. (dc1, dec) x12 (16)
36. dec around x8 (8)

- Fasten off, and stuff firmly and close the hole up.

Mouth:

In B - Light Brown

1. ch5, dc2 in 2nd ch from hook, slst x3, dc2 in last st, working on other side of starting ch, dc2 in next st, dc4 (13).
2. inc x2, slst4, inc x2, dc5 (17).

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Using a strand of H, sew mouth detail onto the left side of the mouth. (See fig.2)

Nose:

In Yarn G – Black

- dc4 into a MR - fasten off leaving a tail for sewing
- Sew the nose onto the top of the mouth - make sure the mouth is the right way up (in a smiling position).

Ears:

In Yarn A – Dark Brown

1. dc6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc2, inc) x6 (24)
- 5-7. dc around (24) - 3 rounds
8. (dc2, dec) x6 (18)
- 9-10. dc around (18) - 2 rounds
11. (dc1,dec) x6 (12)
- 12-15. dc around (12) - 4 rounds
16. dec in each st around (6)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Legs (make 2):**Start in Yarn A – Dark Brown**

1. dc6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
- 3-4. dc around - 2 rounds (12)
5. Change to sand, dc around (12)
- 6-9. dc around (12)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Stuff firmly.

Arms (make 2):**Start in Yarn A – Dark Brown**

1. dc6 into a MR
2. (dc2, inc) x2 (8)
3. (dc3, inc) x2 (10)
- 4-9. Change to yarn D, dc around - 6 rounds (10)
10. (dc3, dec) x2 (8)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Tie (top):**In Yarn F – Navy**

1. ch3, dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc (2)

- Fasten off

Tie (main):**In Yarn C – Lemon Yellow**

1. ch7, dc in 2nd ch from hook, dc5 (6)

- Fasten off
- Grab your top tie and bottom tie and sew them together - make sure the top piece is placed over the top of the bottom.
- Sew the completed tie to Duggee's body.

Assembly:

- Sew Duggee's ears onto his head four rows from the beginning and four st apart - make sure his ears are quite far back on his head see fig.3.
- Sew his legs onto the bottom of his body about one st apart.
- Sew his arms onto his body in line with the bottom of his ears and just where the second colour change on his body starts.
- Grab four strands of any yarn in orange, pink, yellow and red for Duggee's badges. Make a big knot in each strand (or ch2 and fasten off). Sew the orange 4 st away from the tie and 1 st down from the second colour change (the same for the yellow on the left side) and the red 1st down from the orange badge (the same with the pink on the left side).

Duggee's Autumn Accessories:

Yarn in any DK:

- Jumper: (I) Dark Green, (J) light green
- Hat: (K) Light green, (L) Teal, (M) Purple
- Detail: (C) Lemon yellow



Jumper:

In Yarn I – Dark Green

1. ch46, connect your last st to your starting st with a dc to make a ring.
 2. dc45 around your starting ch (45)
 - 3-5. dc around - 3 rounds (45)
 6. (dc14, inc) x3 (48)
 - 7-9. dc around (48)
- Without fastening off, we will be working in rows making the front and back panels of the jumper. (f = front b = back)
- 10 (f). ch1, turn, dc 21 (21)
 - 11 (f). ch1, turn, dc21 (21)
 - 10 (b). Fasten off and attach yarn four stitches from where you just fastened off, on row 9 of starting rounds, dc19 (19) see fig.4
 - 11(b). ch1, turn, dc 19 (19)

12. ch8 and connect to the front side, dc 21, ch8 and connect to the back - this creates the arm holes (56) see fig.5

13. Change to J, dc8 across the ch8, dc21, dc8 across the ch8, dc19 (56)

14. dc around (56)

- Fasten off and weave in ends.

Jumper arms:

In Yarn I – Dark Green

- Turn the jumper inside out.

1. Attach the yarn to any st in your armhole and dc17 around (17) see fig.6
2. 2-6. dc around - 5 rounds (17)

- Fasten off and weave in ends and repeat the above on the other arm.

Jumper finishing touches:

- Grab a long strand of C, fold the light green trim of Duggee's jumper down and sew it in place using the yellow thread to create the trim detail (see fig.7)
- Similarly to Duggee's badges, take a piece of any orange yarn and ch2, fasten off and sew to the front of the jumper on the left side (Duggee's right).

Hat:

Start in Yarn L - Teal

1. dc6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (dc3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (dc4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (dc5, inc) x6 (42)
8. (dc6, inc) x6 (48)

9-11. dc around (48)

12. ch to J, dc around (48)

13-16. dc around - 4 rounds (48)

- Fasten off and weave in ends.
- Grab a long strand of Lemon yellow - fold the light green trim of Duggee's hat up and sew it in place using the yellow thread to create the trim detail. (see fig.8)

Hat Bobble:

In Yarn M - Purple

1. dc6 into a MR
 2. (dc2, inc) x2 (8)
 3. dc around (8)
 4. (dc2, dec) x2 (6)
- Fasten off and weave in ends.
 - Sew bobble onto the top of the hat, over the starting MR.
