

# HEY DUGGEE

## Hey Duggee – Christmas Crochet Enid Pattern by Cornish Selkie (Siobhán Eardley)



### **Head:**

Starting in Yarn **A**: Warm Yellow

1. ch13, dc in 2nd ch, dc 10, in last st dc3, now start to dc along the other side of the ch, dc11 (26)
  2. dc1, inc, dc10, inc, dc1, inc, dc 10, inc (30)
  3. dc2, inc, dc14, inc, dc2, inc, dc12 (33)
- 4-12. dc around (33) x9 rounds - **place safety eyes between R 5&6 1st apart**
13. In BLO, dc1, dec, dc15, dec, dc13 (31)
  14. dec 15, dc1 (16)
  15. dec 7, dc1 (8)
- Fasten off and pull the end hold tight and weave in ends.

### **Materials needed:**

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle
- Toy stuffing
- 5mm safety eyes (x2)

### **Any DK Yarn in:**

- **A** - Warm yellow x1 ball
- **B** - Orange x1 ball
- **C** - Pink x1 ball
- **D** - Light Yellow x1 ball
- **E** - White x1 ball

### **Terminology (UK Terms):**

- slst: slip stitch
- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- MR: Magic ring
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease
- BLO: Back loop only
- FLO: front loop only

**Body:**

Starting in **Yarn A:** Warm Yellow

1. dc6 into a MR
  2. inc around (12)
  3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
  4. (dc2, inc) x6 (24)
  5. (dc3, inc) x6 (30)
  6. In BLO, dc around (30)
  - 7-8. dc around (30) - x2 rounds
  9. Change to **Yarn B:** Orange, dc around (30)
  10. dc1, dec x2, dc 23, dec (27)
  11. Change to **Yarn A:** Warm Yellow, dc1, decx2, dc18, decx2 (23)
  12. dc around (23)
  13. dc1, decx2, dc13, decx2 (18)
  - 14-15. dc around (18)- x2 rounds
  16. Change to **Yarn C:** Pink, dc around (18)
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

**Tail:**

Starting in **Yarn E** - White

1. dc6 into a MR
  2. dc around (6)
  3. Change to **Yarn A:** Warm Yellow, dc around (6) - **stuff the tail as you go.**
  - 4-11. dc around (6) - x8 rounds
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

**Paws:**

In **Yarn E** - White - make 2

1. dc6 into a MR
  - 2-3. dc around (6)
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

**Nose:**

In **Yarn C**: Pink

1. dc6 into a MR
- Fasten off and weave in ends leaving a tail for sewing.

**Collar Tag:**

In **Yarn D** - Light Yellow

1. dc4 into a MR
- Fasten off and weave in ends leaving a tail for sewing.

**Ears:**

In **Yarn B**: Orange - make 2

1. dc6 into a MR
  2. dc around (6)
  3. (dc1, inc) x3 (9)
  4. (dc2, inc) x3 (12)
- 5-6. dc around (12) x2 rounds
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

**Assembly:**

- Sew the nose onto the head 4 rows up from the BLO row (row 13) and in the centre of the head just below the eyes (see Fig.1).
- Sew the body to the head (see Fig.1).
- Sew the tail onto the side of the body at the bottom (see Fig.2)
- Sew the collar tag on just where the pink collar starts, in line with the nose.
- Sew the ears in place on the top of Enid's head, so they are touching (see Fig.3)
- Using the same yarn as the ears (**Yarn B**: Orange), sew on the face detailing, whiskers and mouth (see Fig.4)
- Sew her paws onto the front of her body a little to the left and just below the two rows of **Yarn B**: Orange colour change and one st apart (see Fig. 5).

## **Enid Santa Hat Pattern:**

### **Any DK Yarn in:**

- **A** - Red x1 ball
- **B** - White x1 ball

### **Main hat:**

Starting in **Yarn A:** Red

1. dc6 into a MR
2. (dc1, inc) x3 (9)
- 3-4. dc around (9) - x3 rounds
5. (dc2, inc) x3 (12)
6. dc around (12)
7. (dc3, inc) x3 (15)
- 8-9. dc around (15) x2 rounds
10. (dc4, inc) x3 (18)
11. dc around (18)
12. (dc5, inc) x3 (21)
13. (dc6, inc) x3 (24)
14. dc around (24)
15. (dc7, inc) x3 (27)
16. (dc8, inc) x3 (30)
17. Change to **Yarn B:** White (dc9, inc) x3 (33)
18. dc around (33)
19. In FLO, dc around (33)
20. dc around (33)
  - Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

### **Bobble:**

In **Yarn B:** White

1. dc6 into a MR
2. (dc1, inc) x3 (9)
3. dc around (9)
  - Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

### **Assembly:**

- Fold up the end of the hat where the FLO is and sew around so the fold is secured.
- Sew the bobble onto the top of the hat.
- Place on Enid's head and (optional) sew to her head.

**And you're all done!**
