Hey Duggee - Crochet Happy

Pattern by Cornish Selkie (Siobhán Eardley)



Head (starting from the tip of the nose):

Starting in **Yarn A:** Green

1. ch11, dc in 2nd ch from hook (10)
- 2-8. dc across (10) x7 rounds

- You will now be working around the edge of the square you've made to neaten it up and will be working in rounds. (fig. 1)

9. dc 2 in the last st, dc6 down the side, dc2 in the corner, dc 8 across the bottom, dc2 in the corner, dc 7 up the last side, dc 2 in the last st (40).

10. In BLO, dc around (40)

11-16. dc around (40)

- You will now go back to working in rows.

17-26. dc 11, ch1, turn (11) x10 rounds (fig.2)

- Fasten off and tie in ends.

Materials needed:

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle
- Toy stuffing
- 8mm safety eyes (x2)

Any DK Yarn in:

- **A** - Green x1 ball
- **B** - Bright blue x1 ball
- **C** - Red Orange x1 ball
- **D** - White x1 ball
- **E** - Black x1 ball

Terminology (UK Terms):

- slst: slip stitch
- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- MR: Magic ring
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease
- BLO: Back loop only

Body:

Starting in **Yarn B:** Bright Blue

1. dc 12, dc in 2nd ch from hook and dc along (11)
 - 2-10. dc along (11) x 10 rounds
- You will now be working around the edge of the square you've made.
11. dc2 in last st, dc7 down the edge, dc2 in corner, dc10 along the bottom, dc2 in corner, dc9 up the side (42).
 12. In BLO, dc around (42)
 - 13-15. dc around (42) x3 rounds
 16. Change to **Yarn C:** Red Orange, dc around (42)
 17. dc around (42)
 18. Change to **Yarn A:** Green, dc around (42)
 - 19-33. dc around (42) x15 rounds

Arms:

Start in **Yarn A:** Green- Make 2

1. dc6 into a MR
 2. (dc2, inc) x2 (8)
 - 3-9. dc around (8) x7 rounds
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing. Stuff firmly at the bottom and lighter at the top.

Legs:

Starting in **Yarn C:** Red Orange - Make 2

1. dc6 into a MR
 2. (dc1, inc) x3 (9)
 3. Change to **Yarn B:** Bright Blue, dc around (9)
 - 4-5. dc around (9) x2 rounds
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing and stuff firmly.

Mouth:

In **Yarn D:** White

1. ch43, slst into 2nd ch from hook and dc 40, sl st in last st (42)
- Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing

Nostrils:

In **Yarn E:** Black- make 2

1. dc4 into MR and tie tight.
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing

Eyes:

In **Yarn D:** White - make 4

1. dc6 into a MR
 2. Inc in each st around (12)
 3. Change to **Yarn B:** Bright Blue and dc around
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Assembly:

- Stuff your body section and the nose, try and get them as firmly stuffed as possible.
- Place the 'flap' of the head over the open top of the body, and line up the two corners of the flaps with the corners of the body - use the base square of the body to help. This stage is important as you don't want Happy's nose to be wonky. (fig. 3)
- Pin the head in place making and sew in place. (fig. 4)
- Stuff the body and the nose/mouth section before you fully secure.
- Place the arms just above the red band of Happy's body, 5 stitches away from where his mouth/nose joins the body. (fig.5)
- Sew his legs onto the base of the body in the center, one row apart. (fig.6)
- Pin the mouth in place, making sure it's equal on both sides of his head and the front of his nose and is 3 rows up from the base of the starting square. (fig.7)
- Grab two of your eye pieces together and sew them together. (fig.8)
- Place safety eyes in the eye pieces and secure them.
- Grab your other two eye pieces, and sew them to the back of the ones with the safety eyes. (fig.9 & 10)
- Pin the eyes onto the top of his head at a slight angle. (fig. 11)
- Sew the nostrils onto the left side of his nose, 4 sts up from his mouth about 2 rows apart - make sure the right-hand side one is slightly overlapping onto the starting square of the nose (you don't want them to be squarely on the side). (fig. 12)

And you're all done!
