Hey Duggee - Crochet Norrie

Pattern by Cornish Selkie (Siobhán Eardley)



Head/ Body:

Starting in **Yarn A:** Light Brown

1. dc6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (dc3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (dc4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (dc5, inc) x6 (42)
- 8-14. dc around (42) x7 rounds
15. (dc5, dec) x6 (36)
16. (dc4, dec) x6 (30)
17. (dc3, dec) x6 (24)
18. (dc2, dec) x6 (18) - **place safety eyes, one in between rows 8 & 9 and the other between row; 9 & 10 - they are meant to be on a diagonal (see Fig.1).**
19. (dc1, dec) x6 (12) - **stuff the head firmly here.**
20. In FLO, dc2 in each st (24)
21. dc around (24)
22. Change to **Yarn B:** Bright Yellow, dc around (24)

Materials needed:

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle
- Toy stuffing
- 5mm safety eyes (x2)

Any DK Yarn in:

- **A** - Light brown x1 ball
- **B** - Bright yellow x1 ball
- **C** - Magenta x1 ball
- **D** - Dusky pink x1 ball
- **E** - Purple x1 ball
- **F** - Dark red x1 ball
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Terminology (UK Terms):

- slst: slip stitch
- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- MR: Magic ring
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease
- BLO: Back loop only

23. Change to **Yarn C:** Magenta, dc around (24)
24-27. dc around (24) x4 rounds
28. (dc3, inc) x6 (30)
29. (dc4, inc) x6 (36)
30-31. dc around (36) x2 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Dress base:

In **Yarn C:** Magenta

1. dc6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (dc3, inc) x6 (30)

- Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Nose:

Starting in **Yarn E:** Purple

1. dc6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
- 4-5. dc around (18) x2 rounds
6. Change to **Yarn A:** Light Brown, dc around (18)
- 7-9. dc around (18) x3 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a long tail.

Ears:

Starting in **Yarn A:** Light Brown - Make 2

1. dc6 into a MR
2. inc into every stitch around (12)
3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
- 4-7. dc around (24) x4 rounds
8. (dc1, dec) x6 (18)
9. (dc2, dec) x3 (9)

Arms:

Start in **Yarn A:** Light Brown- make 2

1. dc6 into a MR
2. (dc2, inc) x2 (8)
3. Change to **Yarn C:** Magenta, dc around (8)
- 4-9. dc around (8) x6 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing. Stuff firmly at the bottom and lighter at the top.

Legs:

Starting in **Yarn D:** Dusky Pink - Make 2

1. dc6 into a MR
2. (dc1, inc) x3 (9)
3. Change to yarn **C,** dc around (9)
- 4-6. dc around (9) x3 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing and stuff firmly.

Mouth:

In **Yarn C:** Magenta

- Ch6 and fasten off leaving a tail.

Tie top:

In **Yarn F:** Dark Red

1. Ch3, dc in 2nd ch, dc 1, fasten off.

Tie main:

In **Yarn B:** Bright Yellow

1. Ch6, dc in 2nd ch and dc 5 (6) - fasten off leaving a tail

Assembly:

- Place the dress base onto the open bottom of the dress as sew in place (see Fig. 2).
- Sew the legs onto the base of the dress (once it has been secured in place) - one row apart (see Fig. 3).
- Sew Norrie's nose onto the head, one st away and one row down from the right eye (so the nose is pointing to the right (see Fig. 4).
- Hold Norrie so her nose is pointing towards you. Sew the first ear onto her head just to the left of the starting MR (see Fig. 6).
- Turn her around again so her nose is facing to the right. Sew the second ear and sew four rows down from the first ear. (see Fig. 7).
- Sew her mouth one st away from the nose and three rows down from the left eye (see Fig. 5).
- Sew the arm onto the body just below the yellow portion of her dress in line with the furthest end of her mouth. (see Fig.8).
- Sew the right arm 10st away from the first arm.
- Sew the top red part of the tie onto the long tie (see Fig.9).
- Sew the full tie onto the body (See Fig.10).
