Chicken Crochet Pattern

Head/ body

In Yarn A: Yellow

1. dc 6 into a MR
2. (dc 1, inc) x3 (9)
3. (dc 2, inc) x3 (12)
4. (dc 3, inc) x3 (15)
5. (dc 4, inc) x3 (18)
6. (dc 5, inc) x3 (21)
7. (dc 6, inc) x3 (24)
8. dc around (24)
9. (dc 7, inc) x3 (27)
10. (dc 8, inc) x3 (30)
11. dc around (30)
12. (dc 9, inc) x3 (33)

Terminology (UK Terms):

- slst: slip stitch
- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- MR: Magic ring
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease
- BLO: Back loop only

Material; needed:

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle
- Toy stuffing

Any DK Cotton Yarn in:

- **A** - Yellow (head/body) 14g
- **B** - Orange (beak and eyes) 1g
- **C** - Red (legs and head detail) 4g

13. (dc 10, inc) x3 (36)
14. dc around (36)
15. (dc 11, inc) x3 (39)
16. (dc 12, inc) x3 (42)
17. dc around (42)
18. (dc 7, inc) x6 (48)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Base of body

In Yarn A: Yellow

1. dc 8 into a MR
2. slst into last st, ch 1, dc into the same st, (dc 3 in next st, dc1) x3, dc 3 in next st (16)
3. slst into last st, ch 1, dc into the same st, dc 1, (dc 3 in the next st, dc 3) x3, dc 3 in the next st, dc1 (24).
4. slst into last st, ch 1, dc into the same st, dc 2, (dc 3 in the next st, dc 5) x3, dc 3 in the next st, dc 2 (32).
5. slst into last st, ch 1, dc into the same st, dc 3, (dc 3 in the next st, dc 7) x3, dc 3 in the next st, dc 3 (40).
6. slst into last st, ch 1, dc into the same st, dc 4, (dc 3 in the next st, dc 9) x3, dc 3 in the next st, dc 4 (48).

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Sew onto the bottom of the body, the stitch count is the same so sew into each stitch so the body forms a pyramid shape around the base square and stuff the body as you go. **See fig.1**

Tail

In Yarn A: Yellow

1. dc 6 into a MR
2. (dc 1, inc) x3 (9)
- 3-4. dc around (9) x2 rounds
5. (dc 1, dec) x3 (6)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Sew onto the body on one of the four sides of your pyramid shape, just off-center. **See fig.2.**

Legs

In Yarn C: Red - **make 2:**

1. dc 6 in a MR
2. (dc 2, inc) x2 (8)
- 3-5. dc around (8) x3 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail.
- Sew to the bottom of the base in the center with 1 st between. **See fig.3**



Head detail:

In Yarn C: Red

Piece 1:

1. dc 6 into a MR
- 2-4. dc around (6) x 3 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Piece 2:

1. dc 6 into a MR
- 2-3. dc around (6) x 2 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Piece 3:

1. dc 6 into a MR
2. dc around (6)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Sew onto the head one below the other on the same side as your tail, slightly to the right of the rail. **See fig. 4**

Beak

In Yarn B: Orange

1. ch 13, dc in 2nd ch from your hook, dc 11 (12)
2. ch 1, turn, dc 12 (12)

- Fasten off leaving a long tail.
- Fold piece in half lengthways and sew together.
- Sew on the front of your body (the side to the left of your tail side) between rows 6 & 9. **See fig. 5**

Eye:

In Yarn B: Orange

- With a length of yarn, sew two vertical lines just above the beak for the eyes. **See fig.5**

Hey Duggee Rabbit

Head/ body

In Yarn A: Grey

1. dc 6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (dc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (dc 4, inc) x6 (36)
- 7-12. dc around (36) x6 rounds
13. (dc 4, dec) x6 (30) - **Insert safety eyes in between row; 9-10 with 1 stitch apart (If making the toy for a child under 3, sew the eyes on in the same position using a strand of black yarn)**
14. (dc 3, dec) x6 (24)
15. (dc 2, dec) x6 (18) - **stuff the head firmly here**
16. (dc 1, dec) x6 (12)
17. dec in each st around (6)
18. In FLO, inc in each st around (12)
19. (dc 1, inc) x6 (18)
20. (dc 2, inc) x6 (24)
- 20-21. dc around (24) - x2 rounds
22. (dc 3, inc) x6 (30)
- 23-27. dc around (30) x5 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Stuff the body and head as firmly as possible.

Base of Body

In Yarn A: Grey

1. dc 6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (dc 3, inc) x6 (30)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Sew onto the base of the body - the stitches are equal and all should match up. **See fig.1**
- Keep stuffing the body as you go.

Materials needed:

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle
- Toy stuffing

Any DK Cotton Yarn in:

- **A** - Grey (head/body) 20g
- **B** - White (Tail, paws and tooth detail) 3g
- **C** - Light Pink (mouth) 3g
- **D** - Blue (Headband) 3g
- **E** - Yellow (Headband) 3g
- **F** - Bright Pink (Headband) 3g
- **G** - Brown (Nose detail) - a small strand



Headband

Starting in Yarn D: Blue

1. ch 37, slst in 2nd ch from the hook, slst 35 (36)
2. Change to **Yarn E:** Yellow, ch 1, turn, dc 36 (36)
3. Change to **Yarn F:** Bright Pink, ch 1, turn, dc 36 (36)

- Fasten off leaving tail for sewing.
- Sew on to the top of the head in line with row 5. **See fig. 2**

Ears

In Yarn A: Grey - **Make 2:**

1. dc 6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc 1, inc) x6 (18)
- 4-5. dc around (18)
6. (dc 1, dec) x6 (12)
- 7-8. dc around (12) x2 rounds
9. (dc 2, dec) x3 (9)
- 10-12. dc around (9) x3 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Sew on the top of the head centrally with 2 st apart. **See fig. 3**

Mouth

In Yarn G: Light Pink

1. ch 6, dc in 2nd st from the hook, dc3, dc3 in next st (you will now work along the other side of the chain), dc 4 (11).

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Grab the length of **Yarn G:** Brown, and sew the nose detail on the top of the nose in the center. **See fig.4**
- Sew the tooth detail below the nose using a small length of **Yarn B:** White **See fig.4**

Tail

In Yarn B: White

1. dc 6 into a MR
2. (dc 2, inc) x2 (8)
3. dc around (8)
4. (dc 2, dec) x2 (6)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing
- Stuff and sew to the body on the right side just in line with the one of the ears. **See fig.5**

Arms:

Start in Yarn B: White

1. dc 6 into a MR
2. dc around (6)
3. Change to **Yarn A:** Grey, dc around (6)
- 4-5. dc around (6) x2 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Sew onto the front of the body two rows down from where the head meets the body with 1 stitch apart. **See fig.6**
