

# HEY DUGGEE

## **Hey Duggee - Crochet Mrs Weaver** **Pattern by Cornish Selkie (Siobhán Eardley)**



### **Terminology (UK Terms):**

- slst: slip stitch
- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- MR: Magic ring
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease

### **Materials needed:**

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle
- Toy stuffing
- 5mm safety eyes (x2)

### **Any DK Yarn in:**

- **A** - Light Brown (head/body) - 14g
- **B** - Pink (Clothes/Mouth)- 12g
- **C** - Dark Pink (Waistband) - 3g
- **D** - Dark Brown (Feet/tail detail) - 2g
- **E** - White (Eyes/Teeth) - 2g
- **F** - Blue (Eye detail) - scrap
- **G** - Black (nose) - 2g
- **H** - Brown (Tail main) - 3g
- **I** - Yellow (scrap)

## **Head/ body:**

Start in **Yarn A:** Light Brown

1. dc6 into a MR
  2. inc in each st around (12)
  3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
  4. (dc2, inc) x6 (24)
  5. (dc3, inc) x6 (30)
  6. (dc4, inc) x6 (36)
  7. (dc5, inc) x6 (42)
  - 8-9. dc around (42) - 2 rounds
  10. (dc6, inc) x6 (48)
  - 11-18. dc around (48) - 8 rounds
  19. Change to **Yarn B:** Pink, and dc around (48)
  - 20-23. dc around (48) - 4 rounds
  24. Change to **Yarn C:** Dark Pink, dc around (48)
  25. dc around (48)
  26. Change to **Yarn B:** Pink, dc around (48)
  - 27-29. dc around (48) - 3 rounds - **Start stuffing here and stuff as you go.**
  30. (dec) x24 (24)
  31. (dc1, dec) x8 (16)
  32. (dec) x8 (8)
- Fasten off, close up hole and weave in ends.

## **Arms (make 2):**

Start in **Yarn A:** Light Brown

1. dc6 into a MR
  2. (dc2, inc) x2 (8)
  3. (dc3, inc) x2 (10)
  4. Change to **Yarn B:** Pink, dc around (10)
- 5-9. dc around (10) - 5 rounds
10. (dc3, dec) x2 (8)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Stuff the hands lightly.

### **Legs (make 2):**

Start in **Yarn D:** Dark Brown

1. dc6 into a MR
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. dc around (12)
4. Change to **Yarn A:** Light Brown, dc around (12)
5. dc around (12)
6. Change to **Yarn B:** Pink, dc around (12)
7. dc around (12)

8-11. dc around (12) - 4 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Stuff firmly.

### **Mouth:**

In **Yarn B:** Pink, make 2

1. dc 6 into a MR
2. inc into each st around (12)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing

### **Teeth:**

In **Yarn E:** White, make 2

1. ch3

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing

### **Nose:**

In **Yarn G:** Black

1. ch 4, dc into 2nd ch from hook, dc 1, dc 3 into last ch, work around the other side of the chain, dc3. (8)
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

**Ears:**

In **Yarn A:** Light Brown, make 2

1. dc 6 into a MR
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

**Eyes:**

In **Yarn E:** White, make 2

1. dc 6 into a MR
- Fasten off leaving the hole open
  - Insert the safety eyes into the holes and tighten and place washer in the back of the eye.

**Tail:**

In **Yarn H:** Brown

1. dc 6 into a MR
  2. inc in each st around (12)
  3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
  - 4-6. dc around (18) - 3 rounds
  7. (dc1, dec) x6 (12)
  8. dc around (12)
  9. (dec) x6 (6)
  - 10-11. dc around (6)
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

## **Assembly:**

- Sew the ears onto the head 6 sts away from the starting MR of the head. **see fig.1**
- Sew the legs onto the bottom of his body about one st apart.
- Sew the eyes onto the head 6 rows down from the starting MR - make sure the two edges of the eyes are touching. **See fig.2**
- Grab a length of **Yarn F:** Blue, and sew to the sides of the eyes. **See fig.3**
- Get your two mouthpieces and sew them loosely together (like with the eyes) - get your two teeth and place them at the bottom of the mouth in the centre. Sew them to the back of the mouth. **See fig. 4 & 5**
- Sew below the eyes, with no gap in between. **See fig.6**
- Sew the nose over where the mouth and the eyes meet. **See fig.7**
- Flatten the tail and get a length of **Yarn D:** Dark Brown and make a criss-cross pattern with stitching on the tail. **See fig.8**
- Sew the tail onto the bottom of the body one st to the right of the right arm in line with r24 of the body. **See fig.8**
- Sew the arms onto his body in line with the bottom of his ears and just where the second colour change on his body starts. **See fig.9**
- Get a length of **Yarn I:** Yellow and sew a triangle detail right below the teeth in line with where the first colour change of the head starts. **See fig. 10**
- Get a small length of **Yarn E:** White and sew two dashes below the yellow triangle.
