Hey Duggee - Wimbledon Crochet

Pattern by Cornish Selkie (Siobhán Eardley)



Jumper

In **Yarn A**:

1. ch46, connect your last st to your starting st with a dc to make a ring.
2. dc45 around your starting ch (45)
3. Change to **Yarn B**, dc around (45)
4. Change to **Yarn C**, dc around (45)
5. Change to **Yarn A**, dc around (45)
6. (dc14, inc) x3 (48)
- 7-9. dc around (48)

- Without fastening off, we will be working in rows making the front and back panels of the jumper. (f = front b = back)

10 (f). ch1, turn, dc 21 (21)

11 (f). ch1, turn, dc21 (21)

10 (b). Fasten off and attach yarn four stitches from where you just fastened off, on row 9 of starting rounds, dc19 (19)

11(b). ch1, turn, dc 19 (19)

Material; needed:

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle

Any DK Yarn in:

- **A** - White Jumper main (head/body) 18g
- **B** - Blue Jumper detail (mouth) 3g
- **C** - Red Jumper detail (neckline) 3g

Terminology (UK Terms):

- slst: slip stitch
- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- MR: Magic ring
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease

Body:

Starting in **Yarn A:** Warm Yellow

1. dc6 into a MR
 2. inc around (12)
 3. (dc1, inc) x6 (18)
 4. (dc2, inc) x6 (24)
 5. (dc3, inc) x6 (30)
 6. In BLO, dc around (30)
 - 7-8. dc around (30) - x2 rounds
 9. Change to **Yarn B:** Orange, dc around (30)
 10. dc1, dec x2, dc 23, dec (27)
 11. Change to **Yarn A:** Warm Yellow, dc1, decx2, dc18, decx2 (23)
 12. dc around (23)
 13. dc1, decx2, dc13, decx2 (18)
 - 14-15. dc around (18)- x2 rounds
 16. Change to **Yarn C:** Pink, dc around (18)
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Tail:

Starting in **Yarn E** - White

1. dc6 into a MR
 2. dc around (6)
 3. Change to **Yarn A:** Warm Yellow, dc around (6) - **stuff the tail as you go.**
- 4-11. dc around (6) - x8 rounds
- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

In **Yarn E** - White - make 2

1. dc6 into a MR
- 2-3. dc around (6)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

12. ch8 and connect to the front side, dc 21, ch8 and connect to the back, dc 19 - this creates the arm holes (56) **see Fig.1**

13. Change to **B**, dc8 across the ch8, dc21, dc8 across the ch8, dc19 (56)

14. In **Yarn C**, dc around (56)

- Fasten off and weave in ends.

Jumper Arms

In **Yarn A**:

- Turn the jumper inside out.

1. Attach to the yarn to any st in the arm hole and dc 17 around (17)

2-6. dc around (17) **See Fig. 2**

Headband

In **Yarn A**:

1. ch 45, dc in 2nd ch, dc along 43 (44).
2. Change to **Yarn B**, dc around (44)
3. Change to **Yarn A**, dc around (44)

- Fasten off leaving tail for sewing.

Assembly:

- Put the jumper on Duggee.
- You can either sew the two ends of your headband closed and weave in the ends, if you haven't sewn your Duggee ears to his head, you can slot this on just under his ears without sewing.
- If you want to sew the headband to Duggee, place the headband on his head and sew the two ends together, making sure to sew it to the head as you do this. So the seam isn't visible, sew this together under his ears. **See Fig. 3**
