Hey Duggee - Crochet Carrot Henge Hats Pattern by Cornish Selkie (Siobhán Eardley)



Terminology (UK Terms):

- slst: slip stitch
- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- MR: Magic ring
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease
- BLO: Back loop only

Materials needed:

- 3.5 or 4mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Darning needle

Yarn:

Any DK Cotton in:

- **A** - Light orange (hat) - 35g
- **B** - Green (Stalks) - 10g
- **C** - Brown (Soil) - 8g
- **D** - Yellow (Hat detail) - 5g
- **E** - Dark orange (Hat detail) - 15g

Hat 1 (Carrot ears)

Main hat

In Yarn **A**: Light orange

1. * dc 6 into a MR (6)
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc 2, inc) x (24)
- 5-7. dc around (24) x3 rounds
8. (dc 2, dec) x6 (18)
- 9-14. dc around (18) x 6 rounds*

- Fasten off your first carrot here and make your second carrot, repeat from * to * and keep your second carrot on the hook.

15. Connect to your first carrot with a dc, and dc 17 around one side, and connect again with a dc, dc 17. (36)
16. (dc 4, inc) x6 (42)
- 17- 20. dc around (42)
21. Change to Yarn **D**: Yellow, in FLO, (dc 5, inc) x6 (48)
22. (dc 6, inc) x6 (54)
23. Change to Yarn **B**: Green, (dc 7, inc) x6 (60)
24. dc around (60)

- Fasten off and weave in ends.
- Sew a crisscross pattern across each ear. **See fig 1**

Stalks

In Yarn **B**: Green

1. ch 20 & fasten off leaving a tail for sewing

- Fold your chain so it has 3 'peaks' sew together at the bottom. **See figs. 2 & 3**

Hat 2 (Triple Carrot)

Main hat

In Yarn **C**: Brown

1. dc 6 into a MR (6)
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (dc 3, inc) x6 (30)

6. (dc 4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (dc 5, inc) x6 (42)
8. (dc 6, inc) x6 (48)
- 9-12. dc around (48) x4 rounds
13. Change to Yarn **B**: Green, dc around (48)
14. dc around (48)

- Fasten off and weave in ends.
- Get a length of Yarn **D**: Yellow and sew the details around the rim, 2 sts apart. **See fig. 4**

Central Carrot

In Yarn **E**: Dark orange

1. dc 6 in a MR (6)
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc 1, inc) x6 (18)
- 4-6. dc around (18) x3 rounds
7. (dc 1, dec) x6 (12)
- 8-11. dc around (12)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing
- Using Yarn **B**: Green, ch 10 and fold in a heart shape and secure the shape by sewing it at the bottom. **See fig. 5**
- Sew the carrot directly in the center of the top of the hat. **See fig. 6**

Small Carrots:

In Yarn **E**: Dark orange, make 2:

1. dc 6 in a MR (6)
2. inc in each st around (12)
- 3-5. dc around (18) x3 rounds
6. (dc 1, dec) x4 (8)
- 7-9. dc around (8) x 3 rounds

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing
- Using Yarn **B**: Green, ch 6, fold in half and sew the bottom, sew to the top of both small carrots. **See fig. 7**
- Sew the two small carrots on either side of the central carrot with 1 st gap between them. **See fig. 6**

Hat 3 (Big Carrot)

Main hat

In Yarn **A**: Light orange

1. dc 6 into a MR (6)
2. inc in each st around (12)
3. (dc 1, inc) x6 (18)
4. (dc 2, inc) x6 (24)
5. (dc 3, inc) x6 (30)
6. (dc 4, inc) x6 (36)
7. (dc 5, inc) x6 (42)
- 8-12. dc around (42) x5 rounds
13. (dc 5, dec) x6 (36)
- 14-18. dc around (36) x5 rounds
19. (dc 5, inc) x6 (42)
- 20-21. dc around (42) x2 rounds
22. Change to Yarn **D**: Yellow, dc around (42)
23. dc around (42)

- Fasten off and weave in ends.
- Using a length of Yarn **E**: Dark orange, sew a crisscross pattern across the front of the hat. **See fig. 8**
- Using a length of Yarn **D**: Yellow, sew a diamond shape in the middle of the hat. **See fig. 9**

Sprout

In Yarn **B**: Green

1. ch 21, dc in 2nd chain from the hook and dc 19 (20)

- Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
- Fold so it has 3 'peaks' and sew them in place at the bottom. **See fig. 10**
- Sew to the top of the hat in the very center.

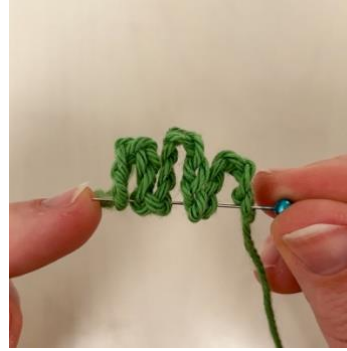

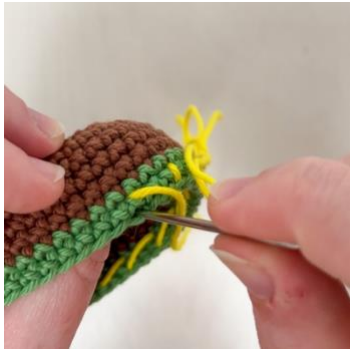

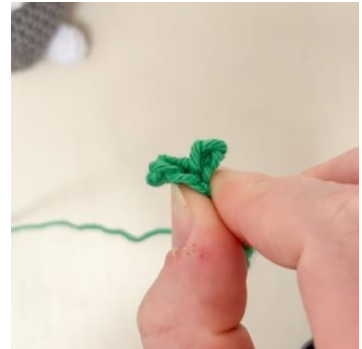
